Thank you Rob - our prayers go with you on the next chapter of your ministry.

With all these farewells, it will be good to welcome back the Revd Stewart Betts following his secondment. Stewart starts back with us this coming Wednesday, and we will look forward to benefiting from all that he has learnt. Some of us will also look forward to the resumption of his Dadjokes!
