### 11<sup>th</sup> - 18<sup>th</sup> MAY 2025 Christian Aid Week

Please support this year's Christian Aid appeal. This charity supports emergencies worldwide but each year the appeal focuses on one particular

cause. This year it is the farmers in Guatemala who are suffering the effects of climate change and Christian Aid wants to fund training and vital tools to help them adapt to these changes. The target is £70K.

There are many ways to donate:

- Online. Go to the Christian Aid website, click on the red 'Donate' tab in the top right hand corner of the screen and it takes you through the process.
- By cash or cheque. There are envelopes at the back of church in which you can put your cash or cheque donation and either hand it to Shân Dyer or leave it in the Parish Office. Alternatively you can put it in a plain envelope and send it to FREEPOST CHRISTIAN AID.
- 3. If you have helped with house-to-house collections in the past, please feel free to take some envelopes to deliver to friends and neighbours. These can again be left at the Parish Office or handed to Shân Dyer
- Through prayer. At the back of the church, you will also find some copies of the Christian Aid Week daily devotional for anyone who would like to take one.

Thank you for choosing to contribute to Christian Aid Week whether it be through your prayers or your donations.

In addition, at Ashby Methodist Church on June 7<sup>th</sup> at 7pm, there will be a concert in support of Christian Aid featuring a number of local musicians.
