As the nights draw in, it can often be a good time to pause and reflect with God. One way of doing this is by using an approach to prayer crystallised by Ignatius of Loyola, The Examen. This way of praying, by looking back over a period of time with God, is well established in the Jesuit tradition. It is also being used more widely through apps like Pray as you go and Lectio 365.

In this quiet day, we'll explore different ways of praying with the Examen. As well as more traditional approaches we will also offer suggestions and opportunities for more creative multisensory approaches to prayer.
